

## VALTESSINIKO

One of the most mountainous villages of Arcadia with about 400 permanent residents, Valtessiniko was built amphitheatrically around the 16th century, at an altitude of 1100 meters on the north side of Mount Mainalo.

It offers panoramic views, traditional architecture, abundant crystal clear waters and lush vegetation of fir, walnut, oak, apple and chestnut trees.

Apart its natural beauty, it has interesting archaeological, medieval and modern times findings of cultural and religious significance.
