

VYTINA – METHYDRIO

Vytina, a mountainous town in the prefecture of Arcadia – Peloponnese, is located at an altitude of 1033 meters on Mount Mainalo in a wooded area dominated by pine trees, firs and chestnuts.

It is one of the most remarkable mountain resorts of the Peloponnese. At a distance of 5 km are located the ruins of the ancient city Methydrio, after the dissolution of which, is believed, Vytina was created.

Methydrio was built by Orhomenos son of Lykaeon at the crossroad that leads to Olympia, Kleitor and Orhomenos, between the rivers Maloita and Mylaon from which bears its name. The inhabitants of this ancient city had been considered a model of calm and Eudemonas life and were well known for their devotion to gods.
