

KELEFAS CASTLE

The imposing castle of Kelefas is located south of the town of Oitylo. It was built by the Turks in 1670, while in 1685 it was invaded by the Maniates in cooperation with the Venetians.

The Venetians perfected it and made it one of the strongest castles.

In 1715 was surrendered to the Turks by treaty and then gradually abandoned.

Today we can see the large external walls, two towers out of the 4 that the castle had, dilapidated buildings inside and one cannon out of the 58 that had during its heyday.
