

NEOLITHIC MUSEUM OF DYROS

The exhibition of the Neolithic Museum of Dyros includes Neolithic figurines, stone and bone tools, pottery, weaving paraphernalia, weapons, jewellery and many small items that indicate the wealth and size of the Neolithic community of Dyros .

The collection is being completed by bones of preys, findings from group burials and the human skeleton of a woman, placed in the last period of occupation of the cave (3200 BC) before being closed by a large earthquake .

Through the exhibition, the visitor becomes acquainted with the daily habits, rituals and artistic pursuits of the people of the Neolithic era, gaining thus, a complete picture of the life of Neolithic man.
