

THE MONASTERY OF THE AEMYLIANS

Inside the canyon of Loussios, in a fascinating environment 3 km. from the small town of Dimitsana, we find the Monastery of the “Aemylians”. Built on the feet of a big rock, almost hanging is dedicated to the birth of Mother Mary.

Initially a hermitage, with a few cells stuck in a cave, the monastery was built around 1600, most probably on the ruins of an older Byzantine one.

The frescoes of the Catholic are the work of the painter Dimitris Moschos (17th century) and are characterized by the traditional Byzantine style and the solemnity of the figures.
