Dimitsana is a town built on a hillside, at an altitude of 950 meters. Its story begins in Homeric times, when in this same position was the Arcadian small town of Tefthis.

It is a large stone village with remarkable mansions, most of which are now restored. The major attractions within the village are the Library of Dimitsana, the mansion of Gregory V, as well as the old and new monasteries of “Philosopher” and the monasteries of “Prodromou” (Baptist) and “Aimialon” inside the canyon of the river Lucius.
