

THE PATHS OF "ARCADIAN SHEPHERDS"

These paths are located on the north side of Mount Mainalo of Arcadia at an altitude of 1500 meters, where is built the village of Valtessiniko. They create a 30 kilometer network of trails that are branching around a central circular route, starting and ending at the Valtessiniko village.

They are called "Arcadian Shepherds" paths, because they express, very graphically, the bucolic landscapes painted by Poussin and the descriptions in the works of Renaissance poets and writers that are praising Arcadia. The Arcadia of myths and values that, through simplicity and humanity, offers the possibility of bliss.
